Inclusion of people with hearing disabilities

Program for people with hearing disabilities to attend concerts and musical events, wearing a vest that allows them to feel the vibrations of music.



Donation of prostheses for amputated children

We donated 300 prostheses for upper and lower limbs to help children with physical disabilities - whether congenital or caused by an accident - to improve their life quality.



Scholarships for young students

Program focused on granting scholarships to support talented students through scholarships to prevent school dropouts and promote quality education.

Hurricane Otis

An unprecedent climate event produced a devastating hurricane that affected Acapulco and near areas. With an incredible support of our community, we fundraised: MXN \$1.5m from clients in our branch network, an additional \$1.5m from our ATMs and \$0.5m from our employees, doubled by HSBC Foundation with a matching fund (total of \$1.m). Furthermore, a collection of 632 boxes of food donated by employees delivered directly to the most affected thanks to our in-site allies
