Restoration of the Natural History Museum

Our volunteer day was held at the Chapultepec Forest Museum, where conservation and maintenance activities such as cleaning, painting of facilities and gardening were carried out. Our team of 120 volunteers participated in the preservation of these public spaces.



Wheelchair assembly

With the help of FHADI, an activity was carried out with the participation of 37 volunteers, in which 15 wheelchairs were assembled, which were delivered to low-income people with motor disabilities.



Green Schools with the Ríos Tarango Foundation in Xochimilco

Green spaces were rehabilitated and infrastructure improvements were made in an educational center. With the help of 27 volunteers from HSBC and students from the same school, we benefited 2,000 students and 100 teachers.



Green Schools with the Ríos Tarango Foundation in Tlalpan

We rehabilitated green spaces and improved infrastructure. With the help of 20 volunteers, we were able to benefit 1,682 students and 89 teachers.



Rally with a cause

Its objective was to promote empathy and break down prejudices. Our team of 23 volunteers had the opportunity to carry out daily activities in wheelchairs in order to achieve a better understanding of the challenges that people with motor disabilities face in their daily lives.



Visit to Casa de la Amistad

It is through volunteering that we change lives. On this occasion, 20 collaborators had the opportunity to visit Casa de la Amistad and live the unique experience of sharing their time and talent in the service of children and young people in Mexico who are fighting cancer.



Family Reforestation 2024:

The largest activity of the year was carried out, which was joined by collaborators and their families: Family Reforestation. With the support of 486 volunteers, 1,500 trees were planted on Cerro de Moctezuma located in Naucalpan, State of Mexico.
